Cottage Packing List

At Viamede Resort, we've included most of the essentials in our cottages. We're all about making life easy for you, so there's not too much you'll need to bring.

There are a few things people always ask us about, so we'll sum those up first. Read on after that for our full suggested packing list. .

- **Do I need to bring sheets and blankets?** Nope. We provide sheets, duvets and pillows - and these are washed between each guest. The duvets are also new, if that matters to you (no vintage floral patterns here).
- **What about towels?** We provide those too. You may wish to bring beach towels, 'cause we don't have those.
- **I love to cook. Do I need to bring my oven?** Our cottages have either an efficiency kitchen (toaster, kettle, microwave, sink, fridge), or a full kitchen (all the above, plus oven/stove, and cupboard space). If you need a full kitchen, please let us know when you book. There's also a BBQ at every cottage.
- **Do you have plates?** All our cottages come with cutlery, basic cooking utensils, plates, bowls, mugs, water and wine glasses, pots and pans. We also provide dish soap, dishcloths and tea towels.
- **What if it rains?** We have a little library of movies, books and board games - you're welcome to borrow whatever you like. We also have toys, darts, and ping pong in our dining room available all day.

Now, here's a list of what you may want to bring. How much to pack is up to you!

Kitchen Supplies

- Spices and condiments

- Kids' and baby items like wipes, diapers, etc.
- Medications, both prescription and over-the-counter, if needed
- First aid kit
- Sunscreen
- Bug spray
- Phone and chargers
- Pack'n'Play and baby monitor if needed
